Day Ladies Rules

1. Curl Canada rules apply.
2. All Games will consist of 8 ends unless losing team elects to concede earlier or scheduled time runs out.
3. The thirds will post the win/loss (Thurs) or scores (Tues)
4. The Match Committee will post the scoring sheets.
5. A game is defaulted if three members of the team are not ready too play after 15 minutes of the scheduled curling time. (One needs to be an original member.)
6. Rescheduling of any game will be done at the discretion of the two skips involved. Match Committee must be informed of the date and time to ensure that the ice will be available and assigned.
7. When a game is defaulted, the defaulting team receives no points, the opposing team 14 points (Tues draw). Thursday draw is win/loss.
8. Team positions can be rotated as agreed upon by the skip and members of the team but cannot be changed during a game.
9. Scoring for Tuesday draw:
 - 10 points for a win
 - 5 points each for a tie
 - 1 point for each end won
 - ½ point for ends not played

THE BUZZER

The buzzer will be sounded `15 minutes before the end of the allotted time. If the last rock of the current end has come to a full stop prior to the buzzer, you may play the next end.

SPARE RULES

1. A maximum of 3 spares are permitted
2. If you are on a 5-man team, then the 5th player should play before asking someone else.
3. **You are responsible for finding your own spare, preferably from within the Carleton Heights Curling Club.**
4. You must notify your skip:
 - a. With the name of your replacement; or
 - b. That you have been unable to find a spare.
5. The spare will play any position at the discretion of the Skip.
6. If both teams have only three (3) players each, they may elect to throw 6 rocks per end instead of 8 per end.

BONSPIELS

1. At the beginning of the season the Match Committee will post the “Dates you Need to Know” which includes the upcoming LCA and INTERCLUB bonspiels (i.e. Centennial, Hope-Beddoe, City of Ottawa and MacDonald/Patterson/Roy).
2. Half-year members may only play in LCA, Interclub or OCA events that occur within the same time frame for which they have paid their membership fees.
3. Prior to these specific events, the Day Ladies’ representatives will post the sign-up sheet and collect the entry fees.
4. The notification of invitational club bonspiels will be posted as they are received.

5. It will be entirely the responsibility of every curler wanting to enter any of these bonspiels to:
 - a. Choose a bonspiel;
 - b. Select a team of their choice; and
 - c. Send in their entry and cheque
