

# 2026/2027 FEE STRUCTURE PROPOSAL

The Fee Structure Committee has reviewed the club's current financial situation and fee structures used by other local curling clubs within the greenbelt. For the 2026-2027 curling season we recommend the implementation of a fee structure with the following components:

- A base membership fee applicable to all members regardless of the number of leagues curled in.
- Per-league fees for each league curled in. Per-league fees are capped at 3 leagues; curlers can still register for additional leagues with no additional per-league fee. Note: The three highest priced leagues will constitute the basis for payment.
- Leagues will have pricing based on league structure, and time of day.
- Day Men and Day Ladies will each count as one league, regardless of the different events/draws they run.
- Little Rocks, Juniors, Learn to Curl, and the Development League will have their own fee structure.
- Teams may have a 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> curler on their team. Every team member must pay the club membership fee. Only 4 team members will be required to pay the league fee. *Note: Carleton Heights Curling Club will not split the league fees among all 5 or 6 team members in this situation.*
- Pro-rated membership and league rates will continue to be offered for those beginning to play later in the season. The fee will be discounted to 75% of the regular fee structure for play beginning in December and be further discounted by 15% per month thereafter (60% of the regular fee in January, etc). All in-season additions are subject to available space within the desired league to join. Please note that the senior and new member discounts will be unavailable for pro-rated play.
- Members are encouraged to reserve their place soon after registration opens for the new league season on April 1. Full payment will be due by October 31, 2026. Curlers with outstanding fees after this date are not allowed to play until fees are paid in full.

This structure provides a fair fee structure within the marketplace while also considering the financial requirements of the club.

## MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVES

- Curling in more than three leagues does not incur any additional fees.
- We offer a 10% discount on league participation for senior curlers (65 years and older as of September 30). Carleton Heights Curling Club is the only Ottawa-area club to offer this kind of seniors' programming, and we are proud to continue it for the 2026/2027 season.
- New curlers to the club will receive their lowest priced league free of charge. A new member is defined as someone who has not been a member at CHCC in the past 5 years (2020 – 2021 season)
- Full-time and part-time students 25 and under receive a 50% discount on league and membership fees.
- Curlers registered in the Day Men or Day Ladies program can curl without any further charge in the Monday/Thursday Recreational Mixed League

The fee structure for CHCC's 2026/27 curling season remains one of the most affordable packages for Ottawa curlers. After reviewing the price structure of other clubs and considering the effects of inflation, we are confident that we offer superb value.
